1: INTRODUCTION

1.1 About iDreamcareer:

2.1 Baseline Assessment

- Why Baseline Assessments Were Conducted

Baseline Assessments were conducted to achieve the following:

- 1. **Initial Skill Evaluation**: To understand students' current life skills, academic preparedness, and career awareness, establishing a clear starting point.
- 2. **Customized Interventions**: To identify individual strengths and weaknesses, allowing tailored programs to address specific needs.
- 3. **Student Engagement**: To actively involve students in assessing their competencies and goals, fostering self-reflection and awareness.
- 4. **Data-Driven Insights**: To collect critical data for evaluating the effectiveness of ongoing and future initiatives.
- 5. **Foundation for Progress Tracking**: To set a benchmark that helps measure growth and improvements during Endline Assessments.

Baseline Assessment Details

The Baseline Assessment (BLA), initiated on June 20 served as the first intervention in the program. A total of 43 questions were presented to the students, covering 12 key areas:

- 1. Time Management
- 2. Personality Development
- 3. Career Awareness
- 4. Critical & Creative Thinking
- 5. Stress Management
- 6. Decision Making
- 7. Effective Communication & Presentation Skills
- 8. Ethical & Moral Values
- 9. Leadership & Management Skills
- 10. Professional Skills
- 11. Self-Awareness
- 12. Self Discipline

2.2 Career Planning Orientation and Aptitude Personality Interest

Career Planning Orientation Overview

In the Career Planning Orientation, we provided students with essential information on:

- 3. **Subject Selection:** Presented the subjects required for Science (Math, Biology, Chemistry), Arts, and Commerce.
- 4. Career Pathways: Demonstrated pathways and opportunities in fields like Science (Math, Biology, Chemistry), Arts, and Commerce through detailed presentations.
- 5. **Scholarship**: More than 200 scholarships for eligible students.
- **6. Dashboard Orientation:** Dashboard Orientation on sundargarhdisha.com provides training to navigate features, track progress, and manage educational data,

This session helped students understand the importance of stream selection and the career possibilities it offers.

2.3 Career Awareness Workshop

API Intervention Details

In the API (Aptitude, Personality, Interest) intervention, students were asked a total of 165 questions, divided into three sections:


- 1. Interest Section
- 2. Personality Section
- 3. Aptitude Section
 - Divided into five parts:
 - i. Numerical Aptitude: Tested mathematical skills and numerical reasoning.
 - ii. Verbal Aptitude: Assessed language and communication abilities.
 - iii. Mechanical Aptitude: Evaluated understanding of mechanical concepts.
 - iv. Reasoning Aptitude: Measured logical thinking and problem-solving skills.
 - v. Spatial Aptitude: Assessed spatial visualization and orientation abilities.
